1. Changes to the post-degree BSW Honours program requirements

<u>Rationale</u>: Changes have been made to the BSW Honours post-degree part-time program in order to maintain consistency with the new direct entry BSW Honours degree. The post-degree BSW Honours program requires 54 credits in Social Work. Post-degree BSW program students will enter Social Work following completion of a 90-credit BA.
