



**Important Information Concerning the April Examination Schedule:
April 23 the Last Day For Courses that Have Continued
and Students Participating in Those Courses**

Communication from the Executive Committee of Senate

March 14, 2018

1. The Executive Committee of Senate has determined that the formal examination schedule for courses that have continued through the Disruption -- and students who are participating in those courses -- will end no later than April 23, 2018.

This guidance does not apply to courses that are currently suspended or to the Osgoode Hall Law School.

2. A fuller set of options for completing courses and finalizing grades is in development and will be communicated shortly. Some of the options will depend on how long the disruption lasts. Students should check the examination schedule frequently.
