## **Update on the Presidential Search Process**

During March and April, the members of the Presidential Search Committee (PSC) have been consulting with the York University community. They:

- held community consultations at Keele Campus on March 22 and at Glendon on March 31 (an additional consultation session is being planned for April 28<sup>th</sup> – more details to come)
- attended the Deans and Principals meeting on March 22
- attended the meeting of Senate on March 31
- have been attending Masters' Council and Faculty Council Meetings throughout late March and early April
- have reached out to Student Group Leaders and have heard from students in several formal and impromptu sessions
- have reached out to Employee Group Leaders to seek their input
- will attend the next meeting of the Board of Governors to seek input from Governors
- have invited input from the YUAA Board
- have reached out to external stakeholders, including past Chancellors and Chairs, government and association leaders, Tri-Council leaders, partners and supporters
- have posted questions and an email address for confidential input and have received almost 50 responses to date.

If you have not yet provided your perspectives, please take a few minutes to do so via email or at the next consultation session.

Committee members will review all of the results of the community consultations and will discuss the feedback during their next two meetings, while also beginning the process of developing the mandate and profile for the next President and Vice-Chancellor of York University. The plan is to post the draft mandate and profile by the end of May, at which time community members will be invited to offer their feedback on the draft. After the Committee members have considered the community feedback, the final version of the mandate and profile should be approved in June, so that it can be shared with prospective candidates.
