York University Board of Governors Synopsis of the 414th Meeting

At its 414th meeting held on June 21, 2010, the Board of Governors of York University:

Approved, on the recommendation of the Governance and Human Resources Committee:

• the re-appointment of the following **Governors** for four year terms effective 1 July 2010 – 30 June 2014:

Mark Lievonen Samuel Schwartz

- the appointment of **Bryan Zarnett** as the **student nominee** to the Board of Governors for a term effective July 1, 2010 June 30, 2012;
- the appointment of **George Tourlakis** as the **Senate nominee** to the Board of Governors for a term effective July 1, 2010 June 30, 2012;
- the appointment of **Debbie Jamieson** as the **non-academic staff employee nominee** to the Board of Governors for a term effective July 1, 2010 June 30, 2012;

Approved, on the recommendation of the Academic Resources Committee the President's June 2010 report on Appointments, Tenure and Promotion;

Approved, on the recommendation of the Finance and Audit Committee:

- the York University Audited Financial Statements for the year ended April 30, 2010;
- the three-year Budget Plan for 2010-11 to 2012-13;
- increases to the short-term (non-permit) parking rates for 2010-11;
- an increase to the **Life Sciences Building project budget** from \$70 million to \$84 million to increase the capacity use of the new building;
- the University Policy on Fraud, Theft and Misappropriation of University Assets;
- Two additional Energy Management Program measures: (1) expenditure of \$1.3 million to complete
 additional academic building lighting upgrades and (2) expenditure of \$1.17 million for remaining chilled
 water upgrades;
- the following 2010-11 rates for **centrally-collected ancillary fees** for undergraduate students and students in graduate professional programs (*implemented as of September 1, 2010*):
 - -an increase from \$18.15 to \$18.54 per credit; and
 - -an increase from \$272.06 to \$278.10 per term for full-time students in programs for which this fee is charged on a per term basis (with part-time students to pay 50% of the full-time fee).
- an increase to the Glendon College Student Union levy from \$1.90 to \$2.40, effective September 1, 2010; and an annual adjustment to the levy in each subsequent year, to increase or decrease in accordance with the Toronto Consumer Price Index (CPI).:
- **tuition fee approvals for 2010-11 and 2011- 2012** in accordance with the Provincial Framework for Tuition fees for Ontario Universities.
