- Tuition fees for the Bachelor of Engineering programs in Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering
- Authorization of the Vice-President Finance & Administration to finalize a 10-year contract (with a 10 year option to York to renew) with Aramark Canada Ltd to provide hospitality services in the Executive Learning Centre, Schulich School of Business
- Authorization of the Board Executive Committee to approve on behalf of the Board the members of the Selection Advisory Committee being struck to propose the next Vice-Chair/Chair-Elect of the Board of Governors
